OTITIS MEDIA

Definition

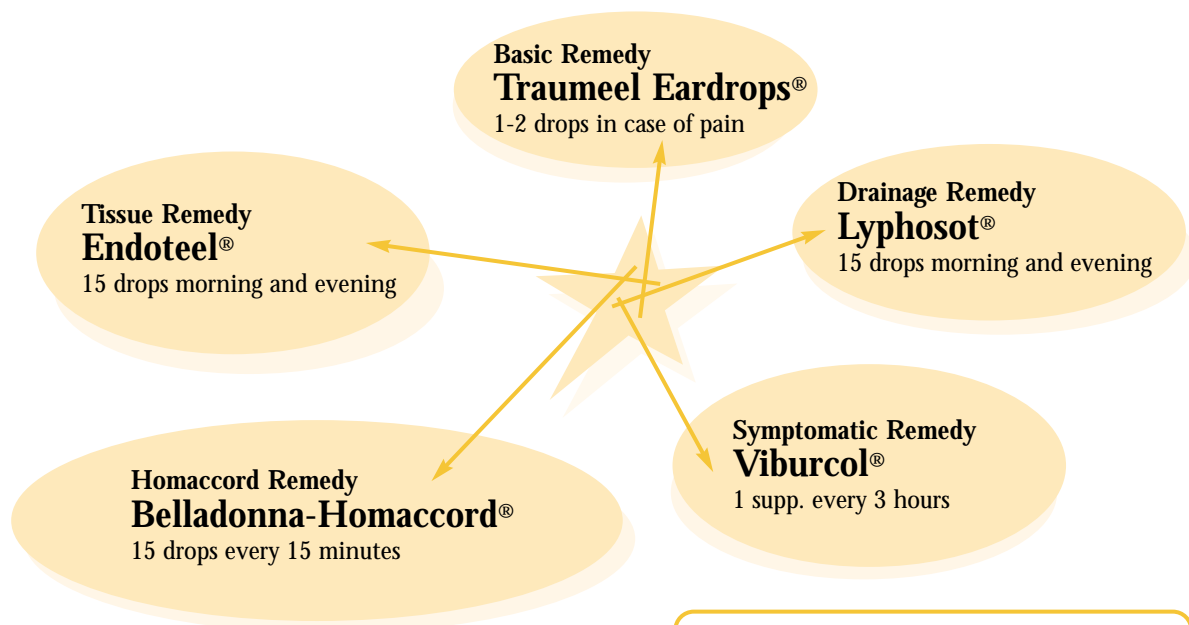
Otitis media is an inflammation of the middle ear that most commonly occurs in infants and children, but may also occur at any age. In most cases the middle ear becomes infected by microorganisms that come from the nasopharynx and enter via the Eustachian tube. Causative pathogens are usually Coxsackie virus, hemolytic streptococci, pneumococci and bacterium coli. It may follow scarlet fever, measles, mumps or influenza.

Usual symptoms:

- Earache, sensation of fullness and pressure in the ear, hearing loss, aural discharge
- Onset following an upper respiratory infection
- Fever and chills

The acute inflammation of the middle ear mucosa is followed by acute suppuration. Often by perforating the eardrum, purulent discharge is found in the ear canal and this often coincides with the cessation of pain.

The suggested homotoxicological approach is to be followed in the first stage of Otitis Media. The practitioner should teach the parents what to do if the child awakes and suffers from the earache in the middle of the night. If we wait days and the child is treated just with painkillers and other suppressing drugs, often the disease passes on to the purulent stage where there is need for antibiotic and cortisone drops at least locally.



You can choose 2 to 3 medications at the most that will fit your patient's needs. See reverse for further examples.

Usual treatment

Belladonna-Homaccord® 15 drops every 15 minutes initially and with improvement every 2-3 hours until recovery

Viburcol® 1 suppository every 3 hours until improvement

Traumeel Eardrops® 1-2 drops directly in the affected ear 4-5 times daily.

Chronic and preventive treatment

Endoteel® 15 drops morning and evening during the cold period and/or for children already affected by Otitis media

Lymphosot® 15 drops morning and evening for a period of 2 months, 2-3 times per year.
